Zero TB city is a project conducted by the Center for Tropical Medicine, Faculty of Medicine, Public Health, and Nursing of Gadjah Mada University (Tropmed) in collaboration with Dinas Kesehatan Yogyakarta, Dinas Kesehatan Kulon Progo, and Burnet Institute, Australia. The project aims to eliminate TB in Yogyakarta and Kulon Progo by applying active case finding, immediate TB treatment, and prevent TB disease among those in high risk of developing the disease. The central team is based in Tropmed UGM, Yogyakarta. The data manager is a member of central team under the leadership of the Project Director of Zero TB city.

Responsibilities

1. Ensure the link among different components of active case finding and contact tracing, such as mobile team, health facilities, geneXpert laboratories, chest X-ray providers.
2. Ensure completeness and validity of data from those different components and prepare the database for analysis of different activities
3. Support research activities of Zero TB city

Activities

Support the completeness and validity from different components of ACF and contact tracing

1. Archive the forms of ACF and contact tracing activities by number order (if paper form is used). If electronic form is used, ensure proper electronic archiving is done by the data manager
2. Verify the forms for completeness and consistency before data entry (if paper form is used)
3. Prepare results tables for presentation and analysis purpose

Ensure the link among different components of active case finding and contact tracing, such as mobile team, health facilities, geneXpert laboratories, chest X-ray providers.

1. Follow up the laboratory results
2. Follow up with Puskesmas to start treatment to TB patients
3. Follow up the results of tuberculin reading by Puskesmas and mobile team
4. Follow up with Puskesmas on the commencement of TB preventive treatment until completion by the participants
5. Prepare report and presentation materials as needed

Support research activities of Zero TB city

1. Follow up ethical clearance and other authorization needed to conduct the ACF activities
2. Develop operational research proposals when needed
3. Be involved in the data analysis of Zero TB city

Qualifications

1. Bachelor degree of health science, ex. medicine, public health, pharmacy
2. Minimum 2 years-experience working in health subjects, such as: managing health facilities, monitoring and evaluation of health programs, managing health researches
