Zero TB city is a project conducted by the Center for Tropical Medicine, Faculty of Medicine, Public Health, and Nursing of Gadjah Mada University (Tropmed) in collaboration with Dinas Kesehatan Yogyakarta, Dinas Kesehatan Kulon Progo, and Burnet Institute, Australia. The project aims to eliminate TB in Yogyakarta and Kulon Progo by applying active case finding, immediate TB treatment, and prevent TB disease among those in high risk of developing the disease.

Health worker population is considered a high risk population to get TB infection dan develop TB disease. A study to measure the rate of TB disease and TB infection among health workers in Zero TB target area is being prepared. Furthermore, TB preventive treatment will be proposed to the health workers with TB infection.
