Zero TB city is a project conducted by the Center for Tropical Medicine, Faculty of Medicine, Public Health, and Nursing of Gadjah Mada University (Tropmed) in collaboration with Dinas Kesehatan Yogyakarta, Dinas Kesehatan Kulon Progo, and Burnet Institute, Australia. The project aims to eliminate tuberculosis (TB) in Yogyakarta and Kulon Progo by applying active case finding, immediate TB treatment, and prevent TB disease among those in high risk of developing the disease.

The active case finding (ACF) team conducts mobile activities in selected areas for TB screening. With digital X-ray machine, delivered in a van, the team screens selected populations to identify presumptive TB cases and take sputum sample from those eligible for laboratory examination. The nurses will support the team by conducting interview, explain the activities to the participants, provide overall assistances to make the participants follow the activities comfortably.

ACF Nurses

Responsibilities

1. Welcome and facilitate the participants during screening activities
2. Conduct interview for symptom screening
3. Conduct tuberculin inoculation
4. Taking sputum samples from participants presumptively having tuberculosis
5. Assist the team leader in preparing the sites
