

The TDR MOOC on IR on infectious diseases of poverty facilitates the dissemination of the concept of IR among key stakeholders (public health researchers and decision-makers, academic and research institutions and public health practitioners). The course helps build capacity in identifying health programme challenges in various settings, assessing existing strategies, and developing new approaches to implementation of interventions by working with key stakeholders. In 2020, 873 participants from 108 countries completed the MOOC in English, French or Spanish.
